### Discussion Prompts

#### 1. Objective Round

- What happened in each article (Post article first, then Nature article)?
  - What is the trolley problem?
  - What decisions do an autonomous car need to make?
  - What were the findings of the Moral Machine study?

#### 2. Reflective Round

- What was your gut reaction to the two articles?
- What were you feeling as you read them?
  - a. Hope, fear, happiness, sadness, etc.?
- What connections can you make to other applications of AI and technology?

#### 3. Interpretive Round

- What are the challenging decisions that AI need to make?
- What are possible inputs that the AI uses to guide its decisions?
- What are the possible problems with how AI decisions are made?

#### 4. Decisional Round

- Is it possible for AI to make "ethical" decisions? If so, what is needed?
- How do we avoid bias in AI decision making?
- How can we take the lessons we learned today and apply them to other AI decisions?
- For example, AI helping mitigate a pandemic?

### Discussion Process

For the Objective and Reflective rounds, we will use an **orbit discussion**

- Each person takes turns saying one idea at a time
- Go around in a circle so everyone talks before anyone repeats
- Go as many rounds as needed so all ideas are shared

For the Interpretive and Decisional rounds, we will use a **talking tokens discussion**

- Everyone has two tokens, speaking up uses one token
- Can go in any order, but should speak exactly twice
