Episode 4: Borda Voting

- 1) Which flavor was selected by Borda Voting (considering the votes of all groups)?

- 2) What is the total ordering of all flavors as a result of Borda Voting? Include the counts of points earned by each flavor to support your results.

Episode 5: Plurality with Elimination Voting

- 1) Which flavor was selected by Plurality with Elimination Voting (considering the votes of all groups)?

- 2) Which flavors were eliminated in which rounds of re-voting? Note: if there were ties for the least number of votes, multiple flavors could be eliminated in the same round.
